FAMILY FUN, DEMONSTRATIONS AND FREE BOATING TIPS AND SAFETY ADVICE THIS SUNDAY

Family fun with boating advice and safety demonstrations will be the order of the day this Sunday at Albury's Noreuil Park foreshore and six locations around NSW.

Member for Albury, Greg Aplin said Roads and Maritime Services, in partnership with the Department of Primary Industries, is inviting the whole family to attend Boating Safety Day.

"The free community event will take place alongside Gone Fishing Day on Sunday 15 October between 9am and 3pm with a range of free activities and advice on safe and responsible boating," Mr Aplin said.

"There will be interactive lifejacket activation and servicing demonstrations, safety equipment and flare demonstrations, essential boating safety equipment talks and free boating displays.

"Roads and Maritime Boating Education Officers and Boating Safety Officers will be on hand to provide important lifejacket information, advice on safe boating practices and information on boat licences, registrations and NSW boating regulations.

"The purpose of Boating Safety Day is to promote safe and responsible boating on NSW waterways through targeted interaction with the public and major stakeholders at local events around the State."
