Funding Announced - 2017 Community Building Partnership Program

The electorate of Albury has secured grant funding of \$300,000 for a total of 17 projects as part of the NSW Government's 2017 Community Building Partnership (CBP) program.

The NSW Government has committed funds to new community infrastructure projects that will enhance much needed local facilities.

Member for Albury, Greg Aplin said he was pleased to receive this State Government funding. The funding will aim to create more vibrant and inclusive communities and deliver positive social, environmental and recreational outcomes. Some of the key projects which successfully obtained a grant include:

- City of Albury RSL Sub-branch, \$37,925 for urgent replacement of roof and guttering at ANZAC House to address leaks and install insulation,
- Albury Wodonga Equestrian Association, \$20,000 for the Sports Arena irrigation project which will allow the surface to be used all year round,
- Howlong Country Golf Club, \$19,040 to renovate and level two croquet courts and develop a third court,
- Tumbarumba Polocrosse Club, \$29,000 to provide a new canteen trailer and generator,
- Henty Community Club, \$20,000 to construct an all-purpose weather shelter for bowlers and for associated electrical items for night use.
- Holbrook Meals on Wheels Service, \$25,000 to purchase a vehicle to support the aged and disabled to access shopping, medical and other appointments locally and in regional and capital cities, and
- Jerilderie Tennis Club, \$13,203 to provide outdoor seating and drinking water to keep bowlers, tennis players, sports users cool and hydrated.

"This grassroots funding will directly benefit our community and will deliver vital new infrastructure and help pay for improvements to local facilities across the electorate."

Mr Aplin congratulates all those organisations that were successful in their application and is pleased this funding will help community groups make a positive difference in the local area.
