### **SCHOOL MAINTENANCE BLITZ FOR GOVERNMENT SCHOOLS**

“Well over half a million dollars will be spent on school maintenance projects across the Albury electorate, commencing over the summer holiday period and carrying on through the year,” Member for Albury, Greg Aplin announced today.

Projects at local schools include:

- \$143,972 for roofing at Albury PS
- \$91,709 for maintenance to flooring at James Fallon High School
- \$88,500 for roofing work for Walbundrie PS
- \$51,895 for roofing work at Albury North PS
- \$35,663 for flooring at Lavington PS
- \$26,964 for roofing work at Corowa South PS
- \$22,684 for flooring at Corowa PS
- \$2879 for painting at Corowa High School
- \$20,098 for painting at Brocklesby PS
- \$16,079 for painting at Culcairn PS
- \$11,572 for roofing work and painting at Rosewood PS
- \$1996 for painting at Jerilderie PS
- \$16,009 for painting at Lowesdale PS
- \$9885 for flooring at Oaklands Central School

“Every child deserves to have access to great facilities, wonderful teachers and get an excellent education and that is what we are delivering for students here,” Mr Aplin said.

Education Minister Rob Stokes said this program is another example of how this Government is committed to public education and delivering local infrastructure to support communities right across NSW.

“Just like your family home, there are always jobs to be done to keep our schools in top condition,” Mr Stokes said.

“We are making good use of the summer break to carry out important projects while students are off enjoying their holidays.

“With a \$25 billion property portfolio of 2,200 schools there will always be maintenance to be done, but good management will keep the list as short as possible, and we are here doing just that.”

The maintenance blitz is part of the NSW Government’s record \$747 million school maintenance investment over the next four years announced in the 2017 Budget, allowing each and every school across the state to have their maintenance project lists slashed by December 2018.
