CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT AWARDED FOR MULTI-MILLION DOLLAR TAFE NSW COROWA CONNECTED LEARNING CENTRE

Member for Albury Greg Aplin today announced TAFE NSW has awarded the construction contract for the TAFE NSW Corowa Connected Learning Centre (CLC) to Joss Construction.

Mr Aplin said the award of the contract would enable the construction of the new state of the art TAFE NSW facility to begin in the coming month.

“The NSW Government’s \$3.7 million investment in the CLC will ensure TAFE NSW not only continues to have a presence in Corowa but will significantly enhance local education offerings and capability for the community,” Mr Aplin said.

“The new CLC will open a whole new variety of opportunities for local students, combining the very best of modern technology and the traditional face to face teaching TAFE NSW is famous for.

“Once the CLC is completed many local students will no longer need to travel to larger centres such as Albury or Wagga to study the right course to get them on their chosen career pathway

“The CLC will be an absolute game changer for education in Corowa and I cannot wait to see the first sod turned when construction on the site begins in the coming month.”

Four CLCs have already been opened in the State with centres in Glen Innes, Coonabarabran, Tenterfield and Quirindi all operational. The Corowa CLC is one of four in the southern part of the State with CLCs in Grenfell, Deniliquin and Narrandera also to be opened next year.

The construction contract for the Corowa CLC was officially awarded to Albury based company JOSS Construction in late January of this year and preparatory works have already begun on the Murray Street site.

Construction of the Corowa CLC is expected to commence later in February 2018.
