FUNDING BOOST FOR LOCAL SHOOTING CLUBS

Member for Albury, Greg Aplin has today announced \$28,000 in NSW Government funding for two local Shooting Clubs as part of the 2017/18 Safe Shooting Program.

Funding has been provided to the following Clubs:

- \$18,000 to the Albury Wodonga Clay Target Club for the extension of a concrete ramp walkway at the Clubhouse to allow disabled access,
- \$10,000 to the Corowa Clay Target Club for the installation of a cooling system and the lining of the Clubhouse walls and ceilings, and

“The main aim of this program is to increase the safety at shooting facilities in NSW as well as during club sponsored activities held away from a club's permanent base,” Mr Aplin said.

“I congratulate our local Clubs on their successful application and look forward to seeing the benefits of this upgrade.

“It is a great pleasure to assist local clubs by providing the funds to increase the availability, standard and quality of local sport facilities,” Mr Aplin added.
