ALBURY AIRPORT TERMINAL UPGRADE COMPLETED

The Special Minister for State, Planning and House, the Hon Anthony Roberts, Member for Albury, Greg Aplin and Albury City Mayor, Kevin Mack today announced the completion of the \$5.7 million upgrade of the Albury Airport Terminal.

Minister Roberts officially opened the new terminal at a ceremony at the airport this morning.

Minister Roberts said the NSW Government was committed to supporting projects which boost tourism in regional areas.

“For all those visitors who fly into Albury, the airport terminal is their first experience of the town, which is why it’s so important to make a strong first impression,” Mr Roberts said.

“I have been travelling to Albury for years and this latest upgrade is first class.

“The Restart NSW Regional Tourism Infrastructure Program has committed more than \$79 million in funding to 31 projects that attract tourist and visitors to our regional towns and cities,” he said.

Of the total \$5.7 million committed to the upgrade, \$3.29 million was delivered through the NSW Government Restart NSW and \$2.41 million from Albury City Council who also managed the project.

Member for Albury, Greg Aplin said the upgraded terminal, which has doubled in size, would make a huge difference to travellers coming through the busy regional airport.

“Albury has one of the main airports in the Murray region, and this upgrade will ensure it can continue to attract visitors and be the key link to Sydney, Melbourne and Canberra for the 180,000 people in region.

“I would like to congratulate Albury City Council staff and contract managers for the excellent work in achieving this vital infrastructure upgrade and the Councils \$2.41 million contribution to this important project,” Mr Aplin said.
