OVER \$2.3M FOR JERILDERIE

Member for Albury, Greg Aplin today announced over \$2.3m in funding to breathe new life into community and local sporting facilities in Jerilderie through round two of the NSW Government's Stronger Country Communities Fund.

Murrumbidgee Council secured NSW Government funding for two projects in Jerilderie, which include upgrades to the Jerilderie Preschool and Long Day Care and to Jerilderie Swimming Pool.

"This is another great outcome for the Murrumbidgee Council, in particular, the Jerilderie community that are part of the Albury electorate.

"The NSW Coalition Government continues to invest in our communities and I congratulate the Jerilderie Preschool and the local swimming community who will benefit from these improvements," Mr Aplin said.

A total of \$2,325,250 will be spent on the two projects in Jerilderie:

- \$994,000 for Jerilderie Preschool and Long Day Care,
- \$1,331,250 for Jerilderie Swimming Pool.

Deputy Premier and Minister for Regional NSW John Barilaro said the roll out of the second round of projects takes Stronger Country Communities funding to \$300 million.

"I congratulate Murrumbidgee Council and the residents of Jerilderie and look forward to the local sports and community facility improvements that will make the region an even more attractive place to work and raise a family," Mr Barilaro said.

"The \$300 million Stronger Country Communities Fund is part of the NSW Government's \$1.6 billion Regional Growth Fund that is employing local tradies, putting local suppliers to work and providing the right environment to operate regional businesses," he said.
